# **Developing Program Outcomes**

### Step 1 – Develop Overview/Context

- Review the University's mission statement (Identify core values of the University see http://www.byuh.edu/about/mission.jsp)
- Review/refine your mission statement (Identify core values of your department/major program)
- What core knowledge, values, attitudes and/or abilities do graduates need to be successful when they leave BYUH?
- How can my department best support student learning?

### Step 2 – Brainstorm

- Review department assessment plans (the current "short" list of outcome statements)
- List all the course objectives from each course within the program by collecting all syllabi
- Search the Web for universities with similar majors/programs (see examples below)
- For professional programs, review requirements by accrediting organizations
- Browse course textbooks for samples of learning outcomes or objective statements (often listed at the beginning of the chapters)

## Step 3 – Refine

- Refine and prioritize your "long" list of outcomes with department faculty
- Look at samples to help refine outcome statement wording

- Effective outcomes focus on the impact that our activities, goals and decisions will have on student learning and/or the support for this learning process.
- It is suggested that each major program should have at least 8-15 well developed major/program outcome statements

## Step 4 – Finalize

- Review long list of outcomes with the Dean of your School/College
- Submit each major program outcomes list to Bill Neal <u>no later than January 21</u> for inclusion in the 2005-2007 University's Catalog (which will be used during our accreditation visits)
